The Chair, Dan McLawhorn, called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone. The roll was called and there were 14 of 18 members present representing the LNBA and 18 of 22 members present representing the NRCA. There was a quorum present for both associations. Guests were introduced and recognized.

Board Minutes – The Board Minutes from the September 19, 2019 meeting were presented and approved as submitted by both Boards.

Financials – *Treasurer's Report* - The Treasurer's Reports for September and October, 2019 were presented by Donald Smith. As of September 25th, the LNBA account balance was \$237,614.27 and NRCA account balance was \$243,362.83. T. J. Lynch made the motion to approve the reports as presented, seconded by Barry Parks, and approved by the Boards.

Haywood Phthisic reported the bank accounts for both the LNBA and NRCA had been transitioned to Civic Federal Credit Union (to replace LGFCU). Donald noted the check issuance process had been streamlined and is more efficient from a time perspective than manual check writing.

Haywood presented an example membership dues table illustrating the NRCA dues with the City of Durham and the Town of Hillsborough joining the NRCA. A proposed budget will be presented at the February Board meeting.

Contractor Agreements – Haywood presented two contractors for the Boards consideration, Sauber Water Quality Consulting (\$3,500 each association) and MFG Consulting, LLC (\$2,000 each association; these

contracts are renewals). Following discussion, Barry Parks made the motion to approve both agreements and authorizing the Chair to execute them, seconded by T. J. Lynch, and approved by the Boards.

990 Tax Returns – Haywood reported the 2018 990 tax returns were emailed to the Board members for review. If there were any questions to please let him know as the reports are due November 15th.

NRCA Total Nitrogen Compliance Summary – Haywood presented a summary of the member's compliance with their individual total nitrogen allocation. The report summarizes compliance from 2003 through 2018. Overall, compliance is outstanding for the membership but may be an item the Board may want to consider additional requirements of its members in the future.

LNBA Sampling Report – Work continues with the Lower Neuse River Monitoring Service Contract No. 5 with Environment I. All sampling was completed by Environment 1 in September and October, 2019. Data sets have been received through August, 2019 and loaded on the website. September sampling results are in data review. All invoices through September, 2019 have been processed and paid.

Dissolved Metals Sampling Request from the Division of Water Resources (DWR) – The Division made a presentation on presented its request for the LNBA to sample and analysis dissolved metals at September Board meeting. Mark Vander Borgh with DWR was at this meeting to answer questions and concerns regarding the Division's request. The Dissolved Metals Committee (Erica Baily, City of Raleigh; Donald Smith, Town of Cary, and Mike Wagner, City of Goldsboro) presented their recommendation to the Board (a map of the sites is included in the agenda package). The recommendation of the committee was:

- * Not to proceed as requested by the Division.
- * The information gained would not benefit the coalition members as a group because the sites were located in a small portion of the basin.
- * The committee would recommend proceeding with sampling for the impaired metals under certain conditions.

Jay Sauber, water quality consultant to the associations, presented additional information for the Board's consideration on the dissolved metals request. Following Jay's presentation and discussion by the Board, Barry Parks made the motion to decline the request from the Division to test the dissolved metals, seconded by James Warren, and approved by the Board.

Meeting with Division of Water Resources – The DWR Director, Linda Culpepper, requested to meet with several associations to introduce the newly appointed Planning Director, Karen Higgins. The UNRBA also attended this meeting. Dan noted the Neuse Plan is behind in its scheduled preparation (2018).

Nutrient Rules and Rules Review Commission (RRC) – Dan reported the nutrient rules went to the RRC and were returned with multiple comment pages. Depending on DWR's response time the rules will return to the RRC in November or December.

The next meeting is scheduled for February 6, 2020 at 10:00 to be hosted by the City of Raleigh. With no further business, the meeting was adjourned.

FY 2020–21 Budget and Finance Committee Recommendation 2/04/2020

Finance Committee Members - Barry Parks, City of Wilson; Chuck Smithwick, Contentnea MSD; and Donald Smith, Town of Cary; and Haywood Phthisic, Executive Director.

The committee (through email discussion and conference call) reviewed the draft budget for FY 2020-21 for the LNBA and NRCA.

LNBA Budget:

* No increase in the proposed budget from FY 2019-20. Membership dues will remain constant for the upcoming.

NRCA Budget:

* No increase in the proposed budget from FY 2019-20. Membership dues will vary due to two new members, the City of Durham and the Town of Hillsborough for FY 2020-21. Members may also see their NRCA dues change due to fluctuations in discharged nitrogen pounds. Budget includes funding of the ModMon Program at the same level as the previous year (\$5,000 from fund balance).
